FRANCE & IRELAND, LEADERS IN TOURISM

The **tourism sector** includes hotels, restaurants, catering, bars, casinos, thalasso therapy, wellness centres and bowling.

As **leading touristic destinations in the world, France and Ireland** generate around **100 billion euros** in hotels, restaurants and travel agencies.

This **dynamic sector** hires more and more people: +50% in the last 15 years. 80% jobs are long-term positions. There are 400,000 winter and summer jobs. **Training in this sector** involves high-standard schools of hospitality and culinary arts and also includes apprenticeship and internships.

- employment in the industry is estimated to 220,000 by the end of 2016

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France
